### HIGH SCHOOL

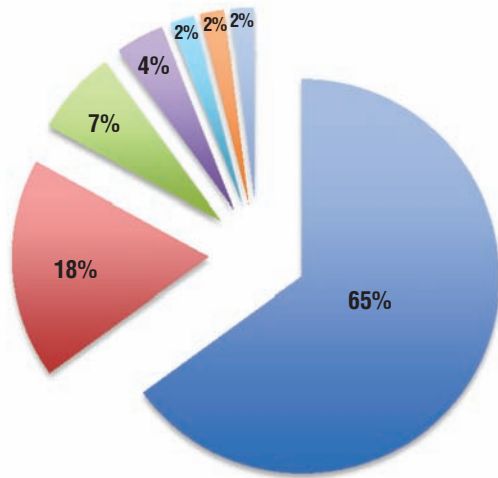
